First Time Listening or Viewing

Example Observation: Individuals cheat themselves out of enjoyable experiences.

2. Quickly SOAPStone the speech. Pay particular attention to tone.

Second Time Listening or Viewing

As you watch or listen a second time, fine-tune your observations from above. Choose the best two observations and turn them into **essential questions** about human behavior.
